BACTERIOLOGICAL SAMPLE INFORMATION:

A bacteriological sample may only be taken from a well that is properly constructed and protected. The fee will not be refunded if your well is not properly constructed and cannot be sampled. However, if the well construction is brought up to minimum standards within one year from the application date, no additional fee will be charged for a bacteriological water sample.

The issuance of a Well Construction Permit by the Health Department in no way guarantees sufficient yield or potable water. It merely indicates potential sources of contamination and setback requirements.

Revisit fees shall be assessed on sites not ready for evaluation, final inspections not ready, pump checks not able to be completed, or any other requested site visit where the site is not ready. No revisit shall be made prior to the revisit fee(s) collected.

Show proposed residence or building footprint, wells, water lines, utility lines, patios, pools, decks, and any other item that may occupy space on the site or is of importance.

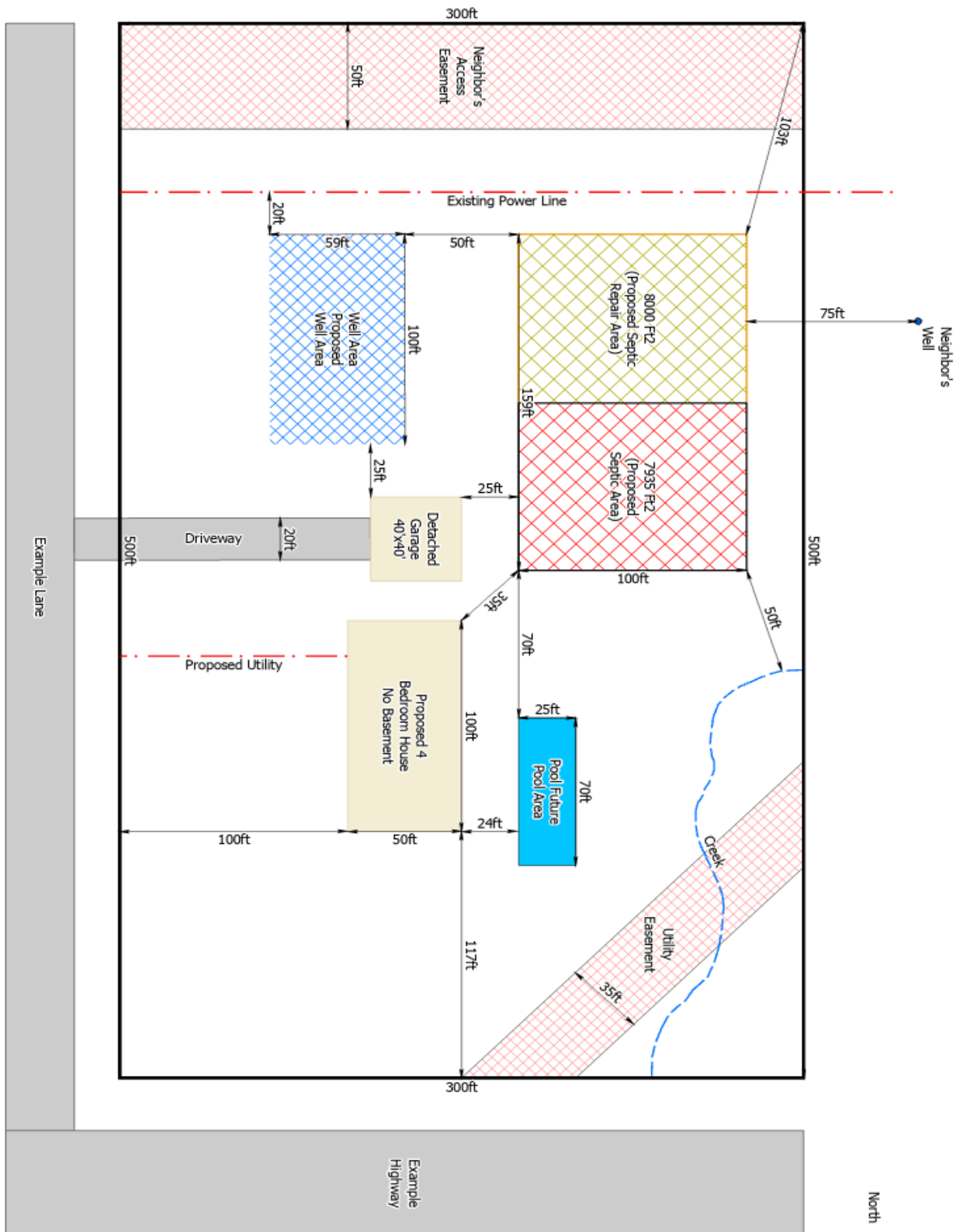
Place an (X) beside each item as you complete the site plan to ensure a complete site plan.

Show all existing and proposed property features

- ☐ Property lines with dimensions (measurements) shown.
- ☐ Facilities, structures, and appurtenances (pools, decks, sidewalks, garages, storage buildings, etc.), shown with dimensions and a minimum of two measurements to property lines or other fixed reference points (property corner, power pole, flagged tree, fence post).
- ☐ Septic systems including repair areas with setbacks to property lines or other fixed reference points.
- ☐ Vehicular traffic areas (driveways or parking areas).
- ☐ Water supplies, wells, springs, irrigation systems, and water lines.
- ☐ Utilities (power lines, gas lines, phone, cable, internet).
- ☐ Surface waters (rivers, streams, creeks lakes, ponds)
- ☐ Drainage features (ditches, pipes, curbs, gutter, and artificial drainage, as applicable).
- ☐ Septic systems and wells within 100' of the property.
- ☐ Easements and rights of ways on the property.
- ☐ Designated wetlands on the property.
- ☐ Other site features of importance
- ☐ Potential sources of contamination, including but not limited to gravesites, above or below ground storage tanks, landfills, fertilizer or chemical storage areas, animal barns, or any structure that requires a building permit.
