Flammable and Combustible Liquid Operations and Above Ground or Underground Tank Permit
Application for Operational use*

Operation Permit in accordance with 2018 NC Fire Prevention Code Section 105.6.17 (Check all that apply)

_____ 1. To use or operate a pipeline for the transportation within facilities of flammable or combustible liquids. This requirement shall not apply to the off-site transportation in pipelines regulated by the Department of Transportation (DOTn) nor does it apply to piping systems.

Fee \$25.00

_____ 2. To store or use Class I liquids in excess of 5 gallons in a building or in excess of 10 gallons outside of a building, except that a permit is not required for the following:

2.1 The storage or use of Class I liquids in the fuel tank of a motor vehicle, aircraft, motorboat, mobile power plant or mobile heating plant, unless such storage, in the opinion of the *Fire Code Official*, would cause an unsafe condition.

2.2 The storage or use of paints, oils, varnishes or similar flammable mixtures where such liquids are stored for maintenance, painting or similar purposes for a period not more than 30 days.

Fee \$25.00

_____ 3. To store, handle or use Class II or Class IIIA liquids in excess of 25 gallons in a building or in excess of 60 gallons outside a building, except for fuel oil used in connection with oil-burning equipment.

Fee \$25.00

_____ 4. To store, handle or use Class IIIB liquids in tanks or portable tanks for fueling motor vehicles at motor fuel-dispensing facilities or where connected to fuel-burning equipment.

Fee \$25.00

_____ 5. To remove Class I or II liquids from an underground storage tank used for fueling motor vehicles by any means other than the *approved*, stationary on-site pumps normally used for dispensing purposes.

Fee \$25.00

_____ 6. To operate tank vehicles, equipment, tanks, plants, terminals, wells, fuel-dispensing stations, refineries, distilleries and similar facilities where flammable and combustible liquids are produced, processed, transported, stored, dispensed or used.

Fee \$50.00

_____ 7. To place temporarily out of service (for more than 90 days) an underground, protected above-ground or above-ground flammable or combustible liquid.

Fee \$75.00

_____ 8. To change the type of contents stored in a flammable or combustible liquid tank to a material that poses a greater hazard than that for which the tank was designed and constructed.

Fee \$50.00

_____ 9. To manufacture, process, blend or refine flammable or combustible liquids.

Fee \$50.00

_____ 10. To engage in the dispensing of liquid fuels into the fuel tanks of motor vehicles at commercial, industrial, governmental or manufacturing establishments.

Fee \$50.00

_____ 11. To utilize a site for the dispensing of liquid fuels from tank vehicles into the fuel tanks of motor vehicles, marine craft and other special equipment at commercial, industrial, governmental or manufacturing establishments.

Fee \$50.00

The full submittal for an Operational Permit shall include this completed application in its entirety along with when applicable manufacturer information on equipment being installed, a site plan, cut sheets, specifications, building layouts, methods of storage and any other pertinent information regarding the storage, use, dispensing and handling of flammable/combustible liquids.

The applicable permit fee(s) shall be included and are non-refundable.

The Davidson County Fire Marshal reserves the right to require any documentation to ensure that the operation is within the provisions set forth in the 2018 NC Fire Prevention Code and all NFPA standards that apply.
