Whereas, in fiscal year 2018-2019 \$12,991,559.06 in child support was collected from non-custodial parents of Davidson County children; and,

Whereas, there are over 6,000 support orders in place to ensure that these children receive financial support from their parents; and,

Whereas, Davidson County Child Support Enforcement staff continues to be one of the top performing programs in the entire State of North Carolina; and,

Whereas, children who do not receive adequate financial and emotional support from their parents may experience greater difficulty in becoming healthy, happy, and productive citizens; and,

Whereas, many concerned and dedicated child support professionals, judges, sheriff's personnel, clerk of court staff, and legal personnel work to establish and enforce child support for Davidson County children.
