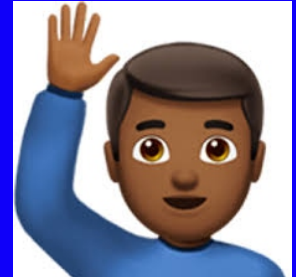

COVID-19 IS HIGHLY CONTAGIOUS **COMMUNITY SPREAD IS OCCURRING**

**As of March 25, Davidson County has 3 positive cases of COVID-19
1 of the 3 cases was acquired via community transmission**

The Davidson County Health Department is conducting contact tracing - we connect with each individual who tests positive, re-trace their actions since symptoms began, we then call close contacts to let them know personally that they have been exposed to COVID-19 and instruct them to quarantine and self-monitor.

If you are experiencing mild symptoms, it is best for you to stay at home and treat your symptoms. If your symptoms worsen, seek medical care.
