Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children.



Serves eligible pregnant, breastfeeding, and non-breastfeeding postpartum women, infants and children up to age five. Provides breastfeeding education and support. WIC is an equal opportunity program.

Health Promotion

Comprised of a Public Health Strategist, two Public Health Educators, and a Substance Abuse Coordinator. This team strives to address public health issues facing our community through prevention and education.



The Health Promotion team works closely with community partners to better serve the needs of Davidson County through outreach and education programs.

Topics may include but are not limited to: Nutrition, Car Seat Safety, Sexual Health, Tobacco/Vaping, Opioids, and chronic diseases.


The Davidson County Health Department provides interpreter services to all clients free of charge.

Breast & Cervical Cancer Control Program

Free or low cost breast and cervical cancer screenings and follow up for women ages 40 to 64 who are uninsured and are income eligible.



Family Planning

Physical exams, lab testing, family planning counseling and education, birth control methods, and appropriate follow up available to men and women. Sliding scale fees based on family size and income.



Adult Health Screenings

Screening and counseling for blood pressure, diabetes, hemoglobin, cholesterol, and urinalysis. Must be 18 or older. Fees may apply.

Maternity

Pregnancy testing—fees may apply. For Davidson County residents, assurance of prenatal care for income eligible participants.

Diabetes Education

Available to all Davidson County Residents. General medication information and nutrition education.



Sexually Transmitted Infection Testing

Free testing for diagnosis and prevention of sexually transmitted diseases. Provides appropriate counseling, treatment and referrals.

Tuberculosis

The NC Tuberculosis Control Program's goal is to quickly diagnose and treat TB, investigate suspected exposures to TB, and encourage preventative treatment for those at risk of developing TB.

Preparedness

Develops plans of response for preparation of a disaster in our community.

Environmental Health

Works to safeguard the public and promote health through the inspections of restaurants, motels, swimming pools, daycare facilities, and more.

This program also completes inspections of waste water systems and wells, in addition to water sampling. Environmental Health also works to prevent rabies outbreaks in the community through investigation, education, and vaccination.



Immunizations

Provides immunizations to children and adults, including travel vaccines. Fees may apply.

Postpartum/Newborn Home Visits

Parents of newborns are offered counseling and support. Mom and baby are assessed by a nurse and appropriate referrals are made if needed.

Care Management for High Risk Pregnancy

Care management provided to Medicaid eligible pregnant woman to assure continuity of other needed medical or social services.

Care Management for At Risk Children (CMARC)

Care management for children birth to 5 who are at risk or have been diagnosed with a developmental delay, disability, chronic illness, or social/emotional disorder.

School Health

A team of nurses dedicated to the three school systems to eliminate or reduce health problems which may impair learning.
