Yadkin River Park

- The Yadkin River Park is a new park in the Davidson County Parks and Recreation system.
- The Park is 53 acres that borders the Yadkin River.
- The Park is being built in 3 phases, this project is in phase 3.
- This phase includes: Bogg Garden and Pollinator Garden (which monies will help build). Three theme playground units.
- Development of a learning center, to be utilized by citizen and children to learn about the environment and the impact on our community.
- Earlier phases included: Restoring 1923 bridge into pedestrian walk way, 2 picnic shelters, primitive campsites, walking trail threw out most of park.
- Over 80,000 people pass the Park on I-85 daily.

Bogg Garden

- The Bogg Garden will have native North Carolina plants.
- The Bogg Garden will offer educational opportunities to homeschoolers, local schools, and NC Wildlife Resource classes, and NC Forestry Service classes, encouraging school children to learn about native water species and how they effect the environment.
