**RESOLUTION OF INTENT AND
CALLED PUBLIC HEARING**

At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Davidson County, North Carolina, held on February 27, 2018, at the Davidson County Governmental Center, the following resolution was unanimously adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Davidson County.

WHEREAS, a Petition to permanently close 2,300 feet of the road described below has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Davidson County, North Carolina; and,

WHEREAS, it appears from the petition that 2,300 feet of Holmes Road has been abandoned by the North Carolina Department of Transportation and will no longer be maintained by the State. Further, the road is no longer used for purposes of access, ingress, egress and regress by the adjacent property owner; and

WHEREAS, it appears that no property owner will be deprived of any access or any ingress and egress to their property and that the proposed closing will not be contrary to public interest and that the best interest of the people of Davidson County will be served by the closing of the street described below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Davidson County that it does hereby declare its intent to close 2,300 feet of Holmes Road, also known as State Road 1377, Tyro Township, as described in Deed Book 2176 at Page 184 in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Davidson County, North Carolina; and that a public hearing on the question of closing said road shall be held before the Board of County Commissioners of Davidson County, North Carolina, at 6:00 p.m. on April 24, 2018, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room, located on the 4th floor of the Governmental Center, 913 N. Greensboro Street, Lexington, North Carolina, and that notice of this resolution shall be advertised and posted as required by law.
